



COVIDSafe Declaration Form – Training & Game Attendance IMPORTANT MANDATORY AGREEMENT

Contax Netball Club is taking a highly precautionary approach to manage the spread of COVID-19 and ensure the safety of our Members and community as we prepare to return to training and games. All decisions are made in line with the directives of National and State Government and Health Authorities along with Netball Australia and Netball SA Guidelines.

All community netball participants (players), parents/guardians of participants, coaches, spectators, officials, volunteers and netball organisations must play a role to help slow the spread of COVID-19. Contax Netball Club has developed our Club COVIDSafe Guidelines as outlined below and available on our Club Website. The safe reintroduction of community netball requires thorough planning, member education and support to ensure that together, we can all minimise risk by adherence to guidelines.

We are seeing your urgent response from all club members and parents to read and acknowledge via the link provided to ensure we all understand our responsibility and agree to abide by regulations set. There is a need for strict compliance for anyone in attendance at training or games at Priceline Stadium along with any other relevant venue as applicable to the Premier League.

We ask our members to help the club with adherence to social distancing at the stadium, please do remind anyone you see not adhering to protocols as we adjust to our new norm.

In preparation for training to resume, it is mandatory that all Members and Parent/caregivers, complete this link via MyNetball by 5pm Monday 18th May, 2020 before they can enter the stadium. Members will confirm agreement to the below:

☐ That you have not travelled overseas within the last 14 days;
☐ That you are not showing signs and symptoms of COVID-19 (fever; flu like symptoms such as coughing, sore throat or headaches; loss of taste or smell or have difficulty breathing) before attending training or games and you agree to keep the club informed should this happen any time throughout season;
☐ That you have not had close or casual contact with a person who has been confirmed with COVID-19, should this happen any time during season you will notify the club prior to attending training or games;
☐ That you will follow the Club directions regarding hand hygiene while at the Stadium, including sanitising your hands prior to commencing training or games and after;



L	\sqcup That parents/caregivers understand only one (1) person may accompany Junior
	player and enter stadium for training or games (until restriction is lifted) however
	where possible, we encourage them to wait in car/outside venue to avoid gatherings.
	When at the stadium, parents must not enter court area and remain in designed
	waiting area or if required to go to court side, keeping 1.5mtr social distancing always;

☐ That you will adhere strictly to the "Get in, Train, Get out" principles of Netball SA

- Enter and Exit Stadium via 2 designated entry & exit points via East and West
- Players to arrive on time for training and go directly to the court
- Players are not permitted to enter the stadium until 10 minutes prior to scheduled training time (to control the number of people at any one time)
- Arrive at stadium ready to train/play (no strapping at courts), provide own filled water bottles, provide own tissues and bag to dispose of tissues, use hand sanitisers on arrival prior to commencing training and on completion
- Exit the courts immediately at designated finish time, proceed directly to cars, no lingering after training or games courtside or in carpark.

Additionally, we ask that you support us to reduce the risk of passing on infections by:

- Avoiding direct contact with other Members, parents and volunteers and exercise social distancing by staying at least 1.5m from others in designated spectator areas or if using bathroom facilities.
- Washing your hands often with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitiser
- Wiping down any surfaces and equipment with sanitiser or disinfectant
- Covering your coughs and sneezes with a tissue or the crook of your elbow.

Should our members have any concerns, please contact me or one of our Management Committee, we are here to help. We will respect parent's decision if you are not comfortable to attend training yet or have concerns with ability to return to play. You can be assured, players will not be discriminated against should this be the case, the club understands there may be vulnerable players or family members and will work with you on what is best for your situation. Please acknowledge you have read and understood the measures put in place by the club and Netball SA prior to entering Priceline Stadium and attending training and games.
