Regarded as one of the best centre court players in the modern era, Natalie von Bertouch was highly-rated for her leadership skills at both Domestic and International level.

Natalie debuted for Contax Netball Club in 1991 as a 7 year old and played a total of 209 club games for Contax. Emerging through our club and programs to the elite level, she was promoted to State League Level in 2000 winning the premiership that year. She debuted in 2002 with Adelaide Thunderbirds.

She was the captain of the Adelaide Thunderbirds in the ANZ Championship and held that position for six years, leading the team to titles in 2010 and 2013.

After making her Australian Diamond Test debut in 2004, she secured 76 Caps for Australia and was a key part of Australia's 2007 Netball World Cup-winning side. She captained Australia for the first time in 2008 in the absence of regular captain Sharelle McMahon. She was appointed Australia's Captain from 2011 leading the Diamonds to back-to-back world titles in Singapore that year.

She retired from all levels of netball in 2013 but remains involved as Ambassador of Contax and participates in our High Performance Academy Programs.
